Preliminary planning is in place for a road improvement project on Hermantown Road from Highway 2 to Ugstad Road, as well as the stretch of Old Midway Road that begins and ends on Midway Road.

Although this project is not scheduled to occur until 2024, the significant size and scope of the effort has us bringing impacted residents and parcel owners together for a discussion at this time.

We have set Thursday, April 6, 2023, as the date for this discussion. We will begin promptly at 5 p.m. and cover topics including the history of Hermantown's large-scale Road Improvement Plan, individual assessments and project funding, specifics related to upgrading your road, and more. We will also field any questions and early concerns.

To meet the needs of those who cannot attend – and with an eye to the number of residents along these roads and the physical size of our Council Chambers – the meeting will also be available via the Zoom platform or by phone.
